Brief Description of Duties for NF 1 Lifeguard:

Observes activities of persons in the pool area to ensure safety rules are followed; assist in maintaining pool; perform rescue work and when necessary, render emergency first aid, complete appropriate accident report; maintain daily logs and records; act as cashier.

Qualification Requirements for NF 1 Lifeguard:

Incumbent must hold a valid Red Cross Lifeguard/First Aid Certificate and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age and able to pass a timed swim and skills test. Must feel comfortable to exercise control over a group of people and present a neat, clean and presentable appearance. This position is considered a position of trust, and applicant must be able to successfully pass background check.

Brief Description of Duties for NF 2 Instructor: Performs a variety of duties in the swimming program, including instruction of various skill levels—beginner through swimmer; assists the Manager in planning and implementation of various classes; observes activities of persons in the pool area to ensure safety rules are followed; assist in maintaining pool; perform rescue work and when necessary, render emergency first aid, complete appropriate accident report; maintain daily logs and records; act as cashier.

Qualification Requirements for NF 2 Instructor: Incumbent must hold a valid Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certificate, Lifeguard/First Aid Certificate, CPR for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age and be able to pass a timed swim and skills test. Feel comfortable exercising control over a group of people and present a neat, clean and presentable appearance. This position is considered a position of trust, and applicant must be able to successfully pass background check.

Conditions of Employment for both levels: Work is performed indoors and requires sustained sitting and a constant vigilance to ensure maximum security of personnel in and around the pool; may be exposed to eye irritation due to chlorinated water. Physical exertion is minimal on routine assignments/ as required for lifesaving. Must be willing to work evenings and weekends.
