

Lodge

The Lodge is a fully-equipped rental facility with 11 bedrooms, a large open seating area with gas fireplace and picture windows, a commercial-size kitchen and dining room. With its rustic charm and old log-cabin style furniture, it can sleep up to 50 people and is perfect for family reunions, small weddings or workplace retreats.

Lodge amenities include:

- Private and family-style rooms with queen, full and bunk beds, dressers, end tables and TV/VCR/DVD.
- Common sitting room with sofas, gas fireplace, hardwood floors and picture windows.
- Commercial kitchen with refrigerator and freezer, convection oven, gas range and grill, industrial size dishwasher, microwave, toasters, coffeepots, and a variety of pots, pans and serving dishes.
- Dining room with buffet tables and seating for approximately 50.
- Bathroom and shower facilities.

Dens

Bobcat and Bear Den are apartment-style accommodations which offer more privacy and amenities, including bedrooms and bathrooms, kitchens and linens. Bear Den, a one-bedroom apartment, can accommodate up to five people and is the only place at Jim Creek with air conditioning. Bobcat Den, a two-bedroom apartment, sleeps five. It includes a dishwasher, washer and dryer. Both are located near the group campsites.

Eagle's Nest RV Park

Nestled in the trees, with spectacular mountain views, each of the 16 sites can accommodate RVs up to 45' long and have water hook-ups, electricity, barbecue grill, picnic table and portable fireplace. Four sites also include telephone and sewer hookups. Shower and restroom facilities are within easy walking distance. Max. occupancy is six people per site, limit of one tent and one vehicle. Overflow parking is available near by.

Campsites

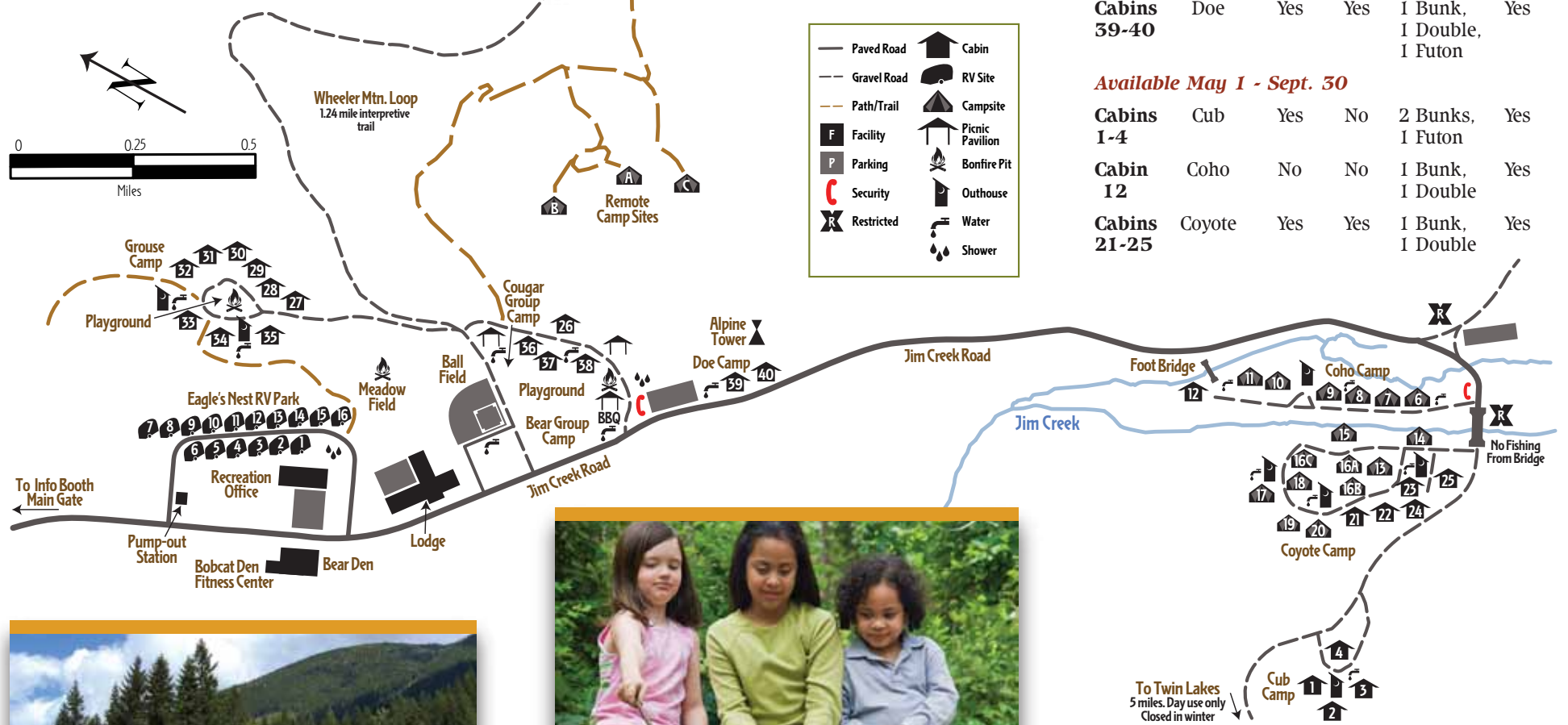
Individual sites: Coho and Coyote Camp have 16 individual sites and can accommodate tents, truck campers and small pop-up tents.

Group Sites: Cougar and Bear campsites are designated to accommodate larger groups of 13 to 75 for tent camping.

Remote Sites: Jim Creek has three remote, backcountry sites. Located approximately 3/4-mile hike out of the main camp area, just off the Wheeler Mountain Loop Trail, these campsites are furnished with a fire pit including grill and elevated, level tent pads.

Cabins

Jim Creek has 25 one and two-room cabins. These cozy cabins feature wood-burning stoves, beds, a small table and bench. Ideal for any time of year, the cabins provide plenty of shade in the summer and cozy warmth in the winter.

Fishing

The Twin Lakes provide some of the best fishing in the area. Available by foot or car, the lakes are regularly stocked with rainbow trout. Rowboats are available to rent daily, kayaks and canoes on weekends. Open May 1 to September 30, for day use only.

Please note: All anglers 6 years of age and older must obtain a Jim Creek fishing permit. Fishermen 15 years of age and older must also possess a valid Washington State Fishing License. Both the Jim Creek fishing permit and Washington State one-day license can be purchased at the Recreation Office, Bldg. 4.

Alpine Tower

The Alpine Tower is a state-of-the-art challenge course, offering a wide variety of team building activities to foster and enhance group dynamics and group cohesion. From a high ropes adventure to a low element program, these custom team-building programs are specifically designed to meet the individual needs of each group. On weekends, when the Alpine Tower is not reserved for groups, it is available for open climbs.



Seasonal Operations

Summer: May 1-Sept. 30 Jim Creek resumes normal campground operations seven days a week with The Twin Lakes, recreation office and on-site store open daily. Regularly scheduled programs are available Friday through Sunday.

Winter: Oct. 1-April 30 Jim Creek is open for day use seven days a week, with overnight stays limited to weekends, holidays and school vacation breaks. Use of the recreation area includes the lower valley area only. On-site services during this season is limited, provided only by our campsite hosts. The Twin Lakes, our recreation rooms and on-site store will not be open during this time. No fishing or boat rentals are available during winter.

Reservation Policy

Jim Creek is open to Active Duty, Reservists, Retirees and DoD Civilians. All guests visiting Jim Creek for overnight accommodations, equipment rentals and programs are required to check-in at the Recreation Office. Bobcat, Bear and Lodge check-in is at 4 p.m. Check-out is at 11 a.m. for all facilities. Jim Creek is not open to the public. Reservations for Active Duty can be made up to 14 months in advance. Reservations for Retirees, Reservists and DoD Employees can be made up to 12 months in advance. Cancellation Policy

In order to receive a refund, a notice of cancellation must be received at least seven days prior to arrival date. Otherwise, the cancellation fee will be equal to the first night's deposit. For the lodge, as well as the group campsites, a notice of cancellation must be received at least 30 days prior to arrival date or the cancellation fee will be equal to the first night's deposit.

Driving Directions

From I-5: Take exit 208, heading east on Hwy. 530, to Arlington. From Arlington, drive 7.5 miles further toward Darrington. Continue 1/2 mile past the Trafton Store/gas station, then turn right onto Jim Creek Road. Drive 7 miles to the main gate.
