Robe Canyon Hike

Start on a bluff high above the thundering South Fork of the Stillaguamish River. Below, alongside the glacial-fed river, the thriving railroad town of Robe once stood. The town is gone, but plenty of artifacts remain of the railroad, the line that once connected Everett with Monte Cristo, now a ghost town. This short hike is an interesting historical outing.
