Camp Times:

6 am-6 pm
Breakfast is served 7-7:30 am. Youth must arrive no later than 7:25 am to participate in the breakfast program.

Camp will be held at the Youth Activities building located at 54 Wake Ave. in Oak Harbor. Please call for directions.

Camp Prices:

\$56-\$115 per session. Prices are set in accordance with DODINST 6060.3 and are based on total family income. Proof of income and valid military/DoD ID must be provided at time of registration for new enrollees. Call 360-257-0889 for an appointment.

Eligibility:

Open to children of eligible Military/DoD patrons.

Ages:

Elementary-aged youth who have successfully completed 2009/10 kindergarten and have not yet entered 6th grade.

Registration:

Register at the Youth Activity Center located at 54 Wake Ave. Regular office hours are Monday-Friday, 6 am-6 pm. Camp space not paid for in full by noon the first day of any camp session will be forfeited and space made available to youth on the waiting list. Call 360-257-0889/3150 for more information.

Cancellations:

All cancellations must be made in writing by June 11 to the School-Age Care Program office. Cancellations received after close the of business, June 11 will be subject to a \$30 cancellation fee. Cancellations made after 12 pm, the Monday two weeks prior to any camp session will not be accepted and the cost of the camp, in full, will be applied to the account regardless of the child's attendance.

General information for: Specialty Camps for Children, Youth and Teens.

Eligibility:

- All children and teens of Active duty, Retiree and DoD family members who fall within the listed age category for each individual camp. Grade eligibility is based on placement during the 2009/10 school year.

Registration:

- Register for all camps at the Youth Activities Center.
- Pre-registration and payment is necessary for each camp.
- Emergency notification cards must be filled out at the Youth Activities Center at the time of registration.
- The Youth Activities Center is open 6 am-6 pm, Monday through Friday for registration. Closed holidays and weekends.

Payment:

- Payment in full must be made at time of registration.
- All cancellations must be made in writing two weeks in advance. Payment may only be refunded if cancellation is made in writing, two weeks prior to camp start date.
- All programs must meet minimum participation requirements. Any payments will be refunded, in full, if activity is cancelled, postponed or rescheduled due to lack of participation.

What to bring:

- Be sure to wear appropriate attire for the camp for which you have registered. Layered clothing works best for Whidbey weather.
- Sunscreen will be needed for outdoor camps.
- Most camps require snacks and/or lunch.
- Always bring a water bottle.
