Age Specific Programs:

With Navy Child and Youth Programs, you can be certain that your children are being well taken care of in a safe, stimulating environment. Focus differs based on the child's age and the program in which they are enrolled.

Eligibility:

- **School Age Care Program:** Children of active duty, active reservists, DoD civilian personnel, and base contractors are eligible. To ensure the high demand for care is met for those in the first three categories, children of retirees are exempt from SAC eligibility.
- **Youth and Teen Programs:** Children of active duty, active reservists, DoD civilian personnel, base contractors, and retired military personnel are eligible.
