Stevens Pass Snow Busses

Saturdays, January 14, February 11 & March 10

This skiing and snowboarding season, ITT will bring you to the snowy summits! Let us take you to two mountains featuring over 1,125 acres of skiable terrain, 37 primary runs and two half pipes with a village at the base. Relax and enjoy the ride and let us handle the roads! Bring your own gear or rent it at the mountain. Military and family members receive \$7 off lift fees at the mountain (must have valid ID). Powder suits and boots are available for rent at Crescent Harbor Adventures. There will be a dinner stop (at guests' expense), on the way home.

Stevens Pass supports our troops! If you are military (including Peace Corps), receive the same great savings as our Stevens Advantage Pass holders by visiting Guest Relations and showing your Military ID. You will be issued a Military Advantage Pass. You must back your Military Advantage Pass with a credit card for direct-to-lift access. Save \$12 off weekday and \$7 off weekend daily ticket rates. Discount is available for military personnel and their dependents only. Must present individual military ID to receive discount. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a qualifying military family member.

The driver will make stops at the Zoo and Mall to shuttle folks to either the Seattle Center or Waterfront. Most attractions offer a military discount at the door with a valid ID. Choose a pick-up and drop-off point:

Seattle Center:

There's so much to do at the Seattle Center! The Space Needle, Experience Music Project, Sci-Fi Museum, Ride the Ducks and Children's Science Museum are located here. The Waterfront is an easy, downhill mile from here.

Waterfront/Downtown:

The beautiful waterfront promenade features many of Seattle's attractions such as seafood restaurants, Argosy Cruises, the Aquarium and the Olympic Sculpture Park. It's only a short walk to Pike Place Market, Pioneer Square and a mile to the Seattle Center.

Northgate Mall:

Shop the day away at the huge variety of men's, women's and children's clothing and shoe shops or take in a movie at Regal Cinemas including IMAX! There are plenty of dining options including California Pizza Kitchen, Red Robin, a food court and more!

Woodland Park Zoo:

This 92-acre zoo is home to over 300 different animal species. The "Family Farm," "Bug World," a Historic Carousel and Zoomazium—an indoor, nature-themed play area for children—are some of the attractions your family will love! Show your military ID at the door for the lowest entry price we've ever seen!
