THERE'S A PEST IN YOUR ROOM?! Better Call the Front Desk!

To avoid insects/pests in your room, you must eliminate their survival sources (food, water and shelter) as much as possible. Sanitation habits play a very important role in pest prevention:

- Wash and put away dishes after use; ensure sink is dry and appliances are wiped down
- Ensure countertops are free of food crumbs and clutter
- Ensure floor is free of food crumbs and mop at least once a week
- Take out trash containing food items or if more than half full
- Throw away unneeded items (papers, boxes, old clothes, expired food)
- Periodically check for moisture problems (along window sills, in the bathroom, under the sink)

Call the UH Front Desk as soon as you see any evidence of pests in your room. Do not apply any kind of insecticides as our contractor uses Navy approved products only.


