

# Costen-Turner Park

NAS WHIDBEY ISLAND

*This expanse of land is named for Lt. Tom Costen and Lt. Charlie Turner, of VA-155, whose A-6 Intruder was shot down over Iraq on the first night of Desert Storm. The park was dedicated in 1995.*



*Organized groups can reserve the park, which features picnic areas, a quarter-mile track, softball field, children's play area and gazebo.*

**Official Command Function:**

No charge. Official Command Functions must be submitted on command letterhead and signed by requesting CO, XO or CMC.

**Authorized Users:**

Fee for authorized users – Active Duty, Retirees, DoD Civilians and Family Members – hosting private parties, birthdays, weddings, etc.: \$40/day.

**Other Groups/Organizations:**

Fee for any group or organization not

affiliated with the base, hosting a party that will have members of the local community in attendance, ie, church groups, boy scouts, businesses, school groups, etc.: \$100/day, with a \$50 reservation hold, pending Command approval.

All groups making reservations for Costen-Turner Park should note that there is a \$50 refundable cleaning deposit, in addition to any fees, that is payable prior to the event and refundable once inspection is completed.
