# Ombudsman Basic Training

#### **Ombudsman Basic Training (OBT)**

provides the foundational information necessary for Ombudsmen to properly execute their duties required by OPNAVINST 1750.1G CH-2. This is a 3-day course, consisting of nine modules designed and standardized by Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) to include resources and information essential for an effective Ombudsman.

OBT is required of all Ombudsmen and is also open to COs, XOs, Chaplains, CMCs, COBs and their spouses.

OBT is available in a virtual class or an on-demand, electronic version.

#### **Ombudsman On-Demand Orientation**

is a 60-minute online training that will provide a brief overview of the OBT to those who wish to learn more about the Ombudsman program. This does not take the place of the OBT.
